



Uniform Policy

Grades K-12

Northside's Modest Dress Code policy is designed to provide a safe and distraction-free environment.

We believe that student attire has a direct effect upon the educational environment and upon the individual student's ability to function at an optimum level within his or her class. We also believe that the learning environment is enhanced when differences in affluence or social affiliation are minimized. Clothing is modest and classic.

Be prepared for weather and inside building temperatures, chapel and PE classes

Christian & patriotic messages are acceptable

Chapel Days - if students want they may dress up

PE: 5th grade - High school must wear gym clothes

Teachers and the Administrator will monitor uniforms to ensure compliance.

Consequences if any item does not meet the requirements:

1. Call home for proper uniform to be brought to school
2. 3 strikes/warnings = teacher will call parent and notify administrator
3. Problem continues: a) student will lose breaks or recess; b) a Parent/Teacher meeting will be scheduled

School Swag Wear:	All NCS school swag is acceptable	All colors
PE Dress:	<p><u>K-4th</u> Comfortable clothing that follow modest guidelines No skirts or jumpers may be worn during PE Class <u>Gym shoes - tennis shoes are required on PE day</u></p> <p><u>5th-12th</u> Change of clothes is required Long Gym shorts or traditional sweatpants - NO yoga pants <u>Gym shoes - tennis shoes are required on PE day</u> No specialty or non-traditional treads (healies or sketcher types)</p>
